Use the full-time equivalent employee (FTE) calculator below to count the number of FTEs you have and see if you qualify for SHOP. The SHOP Marketplace is open to employers with 50 or fewer full-time equivalent employees (FTEs). [Learn how FTEs are calculated.](#)

Note: Enter the number of employees who work for 30 or more hours per week.

Enter the hours worked per year by part-time employees

Full-time employees are those who worked on average 30 hours or more a week for more than 120 days in a year - or the number of employees you expect to work these hours.

Part-time employees are those who worked on average less than 30 hours per week, but more than 120 days per year.

If the total number of hours worked isn't a whole number, round it down to the nearest whole number.
