

GET CONNECTED AT HOME WITH A FEDERAL DISCOUNT ON YOUR INTERNET BILL



Has your family struggled to afford internet access at home during the pandemic?

THE EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM CAN HELP!

The **Emergency Broadband Benefit** is a temporary program from the FCC that provides **eligible households discounts of up to \$50 a month** for your internet bill (\$75 on qualifying Tribal lands).

Participants also get a one-time **discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer or tablet** (purchased through a participating provider).

WHO QUALIFIES?

Any household with a member that:

- Has income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines**, or participates in other government assistance programs
- Receives **free or reduced school lunch or breakfast**
- Received a **Federal Pell Grant** this year
- Lost significant income due to job loss or furlough** since February 29, 2020
- Meets low-income criteria for a COVID-19 program** or a participating provider's program

HOW CAN I APPLY?

- 1** Contact your preferred participating provider directly to learn about their application process
- 2** Go to [GetEmergencyBroadband.org](https://www.getemergencybroadband.org) to submit an application and find participating providers near you
- 3** Complete a **mail-in application** and send it along with proof of eligibility to:
