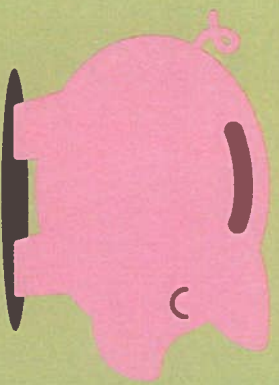


Saving you money, serving the community

Preferred Pricing Program

Member communities can buy electricity and natural gas for their municipal loads at cost. That means your government gets the absolute best pricing available from NOPEC.

Energy-Efficiency Financing

Up-front, fixed-rate financing options for energy-efficiency projects allows commercial property owners to use the savings generated by improvements to help pay back the loan. Financing is available with rates as low as 2.5% for qualifying projects ranging from \$5,000 - \$500,000.

NOPEC Energized Community (NEC) Grant Program

Provides grant money to member communities for energy-efficiency projects.

Charging Stations

NextEra, NOPEC's energy supplier, is providing 40 electric car charging stations and electric car leases for municipal use in NOPEC

Each month, we send information on a funding or grant program available to your community. Looking for a specific funding opportunity? Let us know and we'll look into it.

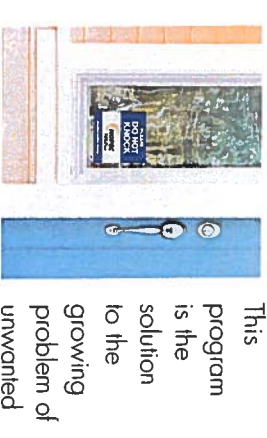


Community Outreach
